The Austrian government established the Climate and Energy Fund in 2007. It contributes towards the realization of a sustainable energy supply by increasing the degree of energy efficiency and promoting the use of renewable sources of energy. Funding from the Climate and Energy Fund is used for broad-based support schemes aimed at private households, e.g. for the installation of photovoltaic systems and wood-fired heating systems, innovative headline projects, model regions as well as the climate impact research programme. KPC awards funding for the aforementioned programmes on behalf of the Climate and Energy Fund.

KPC services the entire support process, acting as an interface between clients, as the providers of funds, and applicants for support. The range of services includes:

- Examination of applications for support in terms of form and substance
- Determination of the amount of support to be granted
- Assistance during decision-making, funding recommendations, services for decision-making bodies
- Drafting contracts and letters of refusal
- Settlement of accounts and management of the disbursement procedure
- Monitoring and reporting
